Urban challenge

Due to its nature, location and topography, Faenza has proved to be particularly exposed to the consequences of climate change, including devastating floods, droughts and extreme temperatures. The city therefore needs to introduce appropriate nature-based solutions to mitigate these risks and attempt to preserve and protect citizens' lives and well-being from the consequences of climate change, ensuring a liveable, healthy and safe city.

Innovative solution

AQUAGREEN takes up the challenge of studying and realising an experimental city model conceived through nature-based solutions to address the challenges caused by extreme weather events. The 'Living Lab' model is designed for and realised in a particular pilot area of the city, which can then be replicated in other areas of the city itself, or in other European cities. The solution allows for constant citizens' involvement and incorporates digital tools to support decision making and informing citizens.
